Tone 6 Troparion (Resurrection)

The Angelic <u>Powers</u> were at Thy tomb;/ the guards became as <u>dead</u> men./ Mary <u>stood</u> by Thy grave, / seeking Thy most pure <u>body</u>./ Thou didst capture hell not being <u>tempted</u> by it./ Thou didst come to the Virgin, <u>granting</u> life.// O Lord, Who didst rise from the dead, <u>glory</u> to Thee.

Tone 8 Troparion (Fathers)

Thou art most <u>glorious</u>, O <u>Christ</u> our God! / Thou hast <u>established</u> the <u>Holy Fathers as lights</u> on the earth./Through them Thou hast <u>guided us</u> to the <u>true Faith.</u>//O greatly compassionate <u>One</u>, <u>glory to Thee!</u>

Tone 4 Troparion (Holy Prince Vladimir)

O holy Prince <u>Vladimir</u>, / thou wast like a merchant in <u>search</u> of fine pearls. / By sending servants to Constantinople for the <u>Or</u>thodox Faith, / thou didst find Christ, the <u>price</u>less Pearl. / He appointed thee to be a<u>noth</u>er Paul,/ washing away in baptism thy physical and spiritual <u>blind</u>ness. / We celebrate thy <u>mem</u>ory, / asking thee to pray for all Orthodox Christians of <u>Rus</u>sia// and for us, thy spiritual <u>chil</u>dren.

Tone 6 Kontakion (Resurrection)

When Christ God the <u>Giver</u> of Life,/ raised all of the dead from the valleys of misery with His <u>mighty</u> hand,/ He bestowed resurrection on the <u>human race.//</u> He is the Savior of all, the Resurrection, the Life, and the <u>God</u> of all.

Tone 8 Kontakion (Fathers)

The Apostles' <u>preaching</u> and the <u>Fa</u>thers' doctrines have established one / <u>Faith</u> for the Church. / Adorned with the <u>robe</u> of truth, <u>wo</u>ven from heavenly the<u>ol</u>ogy,//it defines and <u>glo</u>rifies the great <u>mys</u>tery of <u>piety</u>.

Matthew 9:27-35 (Gospel)

When Jesus departed from there, two blind men followed Him, crying out and saying, "Son of David, have mercy on us!" And when He had come into the house, the blind men came to Him. And Jesus said to them, "Do you believe that I am able to do this?" They said to Him, "Yes, Lord." Then He touched their eyes, saying, "According to your faith let it be to you." And their eyes were opened. And Jesus sternly warned them, saying, "See that no one knows it." But when they had departed, they spread the news about Him in all that country. As they went out, behold, they brought to Him a man, mute and demon-possessed. And when the demon was cast out, the mute spoke. And the multitudes marveled, never seen like this in Israel!" But the Pharisaying, "It was sees said, "He casts out demons by the ruler of the demons." Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

On the day that her family piled into the station wagon to visit their grandmother, Sarah asked her mother, "Mom, where does God go for summer vacation?"

Her mother chuckled at the question, and told her God doesn't go on vacation.

Sarah wondered, "Why don't we go to church then? Why isn't there any Sunday School? Why don't I get to see my church friends?"

Her parents weren't really prepared to deal with questions like this! What could they say? After all, God wasn't on vacation... they were! Imagine her parents' surprise when they realized their little daughter had "stumped them." They just didn't know how to answer her question. But what was really great was that they were worried enough about it to look for an answer!

Until now, her parents thought: Church was only a 2-hour responsibility on Sunday mornings. For Sarah though, it was a different story. She lived what she learned. Church wasn't just an obligation for her. No way! In fact, it was a way of living... a way of being!
